

COMMUNITY GRANTS GUIDELINES 2023

Big Sister Foundation invites not-for-profit community organisations registered with the ACNC and operating within the Georges River, Bayside and Sutherland Shire LGA's to apply for community grant funding.

Applications are open to organisations requiring funding for programs and support services to assist women and families in need and to provide opportunities that enable women and girls to make the most of their lives.

Applications for grants from \$5,000 to \$100,000 (ex GST) will be accepted.

Community grant applications must demonstrate how the program will be measured and evaluated and the proposed program outcomes.

Grants are awarded for different purposes including early intervention programs; crisis services; for delivering education, mentoring and participation activities; for research, evaluation and evidence of program outcomes.

Applications for services supporting women and girls in southern Sydney from culturally diverse groups and communities including CALD, LGBTI, indigenous women and refugees are encouraged.

Grants will not be awarded to fund • Activities of a commercial nature, however social enterprises will be considered favourably. • Support of an individual • Support for political or religious purposes.

Applicants will be contacted initially to acknowledge receipt and then notified of the outcome within 4-6 weeks of application (subject to board meeting approvals) .

Organisation

Program/Service

1. Program Name and Outline – please provide a description of your program in 300 - 500 words max. Please do not send other attachments, links are fine.
2. Proposed start and finish dates for program.
3. Primary problem you are solving/theory of change/specific goals.
4. Scope of program and primary target group for which your program/service is designed.
5. Geographical area/s where it will be delivered.
6. Organisations who are offering the same or similar services in the local area.

Funding Required

1. How much funding in total do you require from BSF?.
2. Please itemise how this funding will be allocated.
3. Please include any additional funding sources available eg: partner co-funding, cash or in-kind donations, government allocation, past fund raising.
